- Primary screening capability established as the #1 priority
- Some secondary screening equipment also purchased
- Distribution plan uses a risk based approach







FY16 Equipment Procurements

- RDD based scenario
- October 23-28, 2017
- Training is being provided in the lead-up to the exercise
- Three tabletop exercises are scheduled
- Evaluate radiological & nuclear preparedness and response
